AIM

The Diploma of Logistics is a general qualification for the integrated management of logistics in the Road and Rail Transport, Warehousing, Storage, Stevedoring and allied industries. The self directed application of knowledge and skills, with substantial depth in some areas where judgement is required in planning and selecting appropriate equipment, services and techniques for self and others.

The Diploma in Logistics should successfully provide learners with a level of understanding that is more than just operations. On completion, you should be conversant with theory, be able to think strategically and have knowledge and skills that would enable you to lead a team or supervise the work of others.

DESIGNED FOR

This course is designed for those seeking or currently working in a supervisory/middle management position in a logistics or supply chain management role.

OUTLINE

Applications involve participation in development of strategic initiatives, as well as personal responsibility and autonomy in performing complex technical operations or organising others. It may include participation in teams including teams concerned with planning and evaluation functions.
