

# Dangerous Goods Awareness for Supervisors



## AIM

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to ensure compliance with the current Australian Dangerous Goods (ADG) Code as part of work undertaken in various contexts within the transport and logistics industry.

It includes ensuring responsibilities for handling and transporting dangerous goods are defined, managing performance and controlling risks, maintaining records and evaluating effectiveness.

Upon successful completion of the course participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment.

## CONTENT

- Responsibilities and duties for transporting and handling dangerous goods
- Any relevant licencing requirements
- Developing and controlling risks based on a hierarchy of control
- Measures to control assessed risks and to monitor conformance in accordance with relevant dangerous goods transport regulations, code of practice and workplace priorities
- Investigating non-conformances
- Identifying Inadequacies in dangerous goods transport procedures and implementing improvement to these practices
- Establishing Dangerous goods records system is in accordance with relevant legislative framework
- Completing accurate workplace records in accordance with dangerous goods transport enterprise policies and legislative requirements
- Collating feedback about effectiveness of dangerous goods transport policies, procedures and programs and providing to senior management
- Proposing to senior management, improvements to dangerous goods transport procedures
