Successful completion will require a successful assessment outcome for 15 units of competency that relate to work defined as aligned at AQF Level 5. On successful completion, applicants will receive a certificate.

This training aims to develop your knowledge, skills and competencies in the field of logistics and supply chain management that will assist you in your management of resources, processes and people and help you become recognised in your workplace for your ability to fulfill more demanding roles.

The program is distinctly multi-disciplinary and aims to provide you with a framework for improving your management action and professional practice and hence the quality of the organisation you work for.

You will undertake a program of learning and activities that fit with the culture and mission of your organisation. To achieve this you will be encouraged to use the protocols and manuals of your organisation as learning materials to undertake assessment tasks that are immediately valuable and take advantage of real problem solving opportunities within your organisation.

QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTION

Achievement of this qualification will require the self-directed application of knowledge and skills, with substantial depth in some areas where judgement is required in planning and selecting appropriate equipment, services and techniques for self and others. Applications involve participation in the development of strategic initiatives as well as personal responsibility and autonomy in performing complex technical operations or organising others.
