## TRAINING INFORMATION:

This course is nationally recognised (LF) and is conducted by experienced Trainer/Assessors who provide supervised experience in operating a conventional forklift.

**Option One** – Log book under supervision of another licensed operator.

Complete formal training in forklift familiarisation, WHS regulations, safety requirements. Upon the familiarisation you will be issued study material, training plan and Log Book. After accumulation of practical hours, a theory assessment (closed book exam), followed by the final practical assessment will be conducted.

**Option Two** – Complete a Structured Forklift Course.

The course comprises supervised theory and practical training. Then a forklift theory assessment (closed book exam), followed by the final Forklift practical assessment.

On successful completion Transqual will issue a statement of attainment and an AS1 Assessment Summary. This is not your licence. To apply for your licence, an application form must be lodged with Queensland Licencing through the online application with your AS1 Assessment Summary. This includes having a QGov account.
