

Load Restraint



AIM

The course provides driver and operators with the knowledge and skills required to restrain loads in accordance with the National Load Restraint Guide. This course outlines the importance of restraining a load on a vehicle, load restraint awareness, introduction of the load restraint guide, general principles of load restraint, arranging loads on a vehicle, restraining loads on a vehicle and driving a laden vehicle.

This training involves the skills and knowledge required to secure cargo including preparing to secure cargo/containers, lashing and unlash cargo, protecting cargo from weather, and packing and unpacking cargo. It may apply in cargo securing contexts in the stevedoring, transport, distribution and allied industries.

CONTENT

This training is a combination of theory and practical, including:

- Procedures for managing and controlling hazardous situations when carrying out work activities
- Problems that can occur when securing cargo or freight and appropriate action that can be taken to resolve the problems
- Workplace procedures and policies for the securing of cargo or freight
- Australian and international standards, codes and regulations relevant to the securing of cargo or freight including the Australian and International Dangerous Goods Codes
- Relevant bond, quarantine or other legislative requirements, handling and safety codes
- Relevant WHS and environmental procedures and regulations
- Apply fatigue management knowledge and techniques
- Identify, select and use relevant equipment, processes and procedures when securing cargo or freight
- Select and use required personal protective equipment conforming to industry and WHS standards
