ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

'TLIF3060 Control Traffic as a Pilot Vehicle Operator' unit of competence must have been undertaken no more than 3 years before an application for a new appointment or a renewal of appointment as an Authorised Escort Vehicle Driver in NSW.

Mandatory OSOM Code of conduct Training is required by Roads and Maritime Services.

APPLICATION FOR AUTHORISATION OF ESCORT VEHICLE DRIVERS THROUGH ROADS AND MARITIME SERVICES NSW

Please note that on successful completion of this course, a Statement of Attainment will be awarded. You will require all six units of competency to assist in your application for Authorisation of Escort Vehicle Drivers from Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) NSW. In addition to the six units you will be required to submit to Roads and Maritime Services:

- A Medical Certificate
- A national criminal history check
- Evidence of experience as a Pilot Vehicle Driver (100 hours and minimum of 20 trips)
