

# Low Risk Driver Training



## AIM

This training involves the skills and knowledge required to recognise motor vehicle road crash risks and post-crash actions in accordance with approved standards, safe working and regulatory requirements. It includes identifying types of motor vehicle crashes, the risks and causes for these crashes, and post-crash actions.

It also involves the skills and knowledge required to demonstrate awareness of interacting with other road users in accordance with approved standards, safe working and regulatory requirements. It includes identifying types of road users, the use and reason for road rules, and potential risk consequences of interacting with road users.

The practical training involves the skills and knowledge required to maintain the safety of and to operate, a commercial vehicle across a variety of job roles. It includes monitoring traffic and associated equipment, managing vehicle condition and performance, and effectively managing hazardous situations.

- Explaining factors that contribute to motor vehicle crashes
- Explaining legal obligations of a driver and others post-crash
- Explaining the common types of major road crashes
- Identifying risk management strategies at a crash scene
- Driving hazards and related defensive driving techniques
- Factors that increase fatigue-related accidents
- Principles of stress management when driving a vehicle
- Procedures to be followed in a driving emergency
- Relevant work health and safety (WHS)/occupational health and safety (OHS) and environmental/emissions procedures and regulations
- Human, environmental and vehicular factors
- Relevant risk factors and how they affect motor vehicle performance
- Low-risk driving behaviours
- Pre-operational checks carried out on vehicle and related action
- Efficient driving techniques
- Engine power management and safe driving strategies
