

NT Accredited Pilot Escort Course



AIM

To provide the skills and knowledge required for those who require an Accredited Pilot Licence/Authority to pilot oversized loads.

PRE-REQUISITES

- Must hold an open Australian or New Zealand driver licence
- Must be of good character (two work related written references must be supplied when applying for this licence)
- Applicant must have no convictions for a disqualifying offence that relates to vehicle control and safety (a current criminal and driving history check must be supplied with your application at Northern Territory Department of Transport).

LICENCE/AUTHORITY APPLICATION

Please note that on successful completion of the course a Statement of Attendance will be awarded. This will be used by Northern Territory Department of Transport to complete your application, initially a Provisional Accredited Pilot authority will be awarded; this authority will expire in six months. During this period ten Oversize Load Piloting jobs greater than 4.5 metres must be completed and recorded in a record of movement book. Once copies of these trips have been received by Transqual a Statement of Attainment will be awarded to enable Northern Territory Department of Transport to complete your application for your Accredited Pilot Authority.
