

Certified Pilot Vehicle Driver (CPVD) Course



AIM

To provide the skills and knowledge required for those who require an Industry Authority card to undertake certified pilot activities in the movement of oversized and/or over mass loads.

The course enables participants to apply to become a Certified Pilot Vehicle Driver (CPVD) through VicRoads. This will allow successful participants to act as a CPVD in Tasmania.

Certified Pilot Driver Authority

Please note that on successful completion of this course you will be issued with a certificate. This is not your Authority to operate. To apply for your Authority, you must complete an application form which can be found here:

Your completed application form will need to be lodged with VicRoads and will need to include:

1. Your training certificate
2. Four passport quality colour photographs
3. Statutory Declaration
4. A fee of \$56

- Must hold a current full Australian driver licence.
- Have completed a minimum of 15 journeys in the 12 months as a pilot. A Statutory Declaration stating this is required.
